



BEFORE FIRST USE

Carefully remove all packaging and assemble the product following the setup & operating instructions below.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Head Unit - Fan Blade & Protection Grill Assembly

- Place the rear grill (6) on the motor housing (7)
- Secure it using the grill nut (5) turn clockwise to tighten by hand, do not over tighten
- Push the fan blade (4) onto the motor drive shaft aligning it carefully
- Secure the fan blade (4) with the fan lock nut (3)
- Assemble the front grill (2) to the rear grill (6)

Base Assembly - Telescopic Tube to Base

- Place the base (12) on the floor
- Insert the telescopic tube (11) into the recess on the top of the base
- Secure using the bolt & washer (13) provided

Head Unit to Base Assembly

- Pull up the telescopic tube (11) and tighten the tube lock nut (10).
 Caution: The height adjustment knob (10) must be fully tightened before assembling the motor section to the pedestal stand assembly.
- Fit the head unit to the base assembly and tighten the securing knob (9). **Caution:** The securing knob (9) must be fully tightened before the fan is switched on.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Make sure that the fan is on a firm and level surface.
- 2. Plug the fan into a standard 230V~ outlet.


Note: The buttons on the control panel and remote control are marked the same - so you can use either of them to control the stand fan.

3. ON



Press the ON/SPEED Button (A) – on 1st use, the unit will start in LOW speed (NORMAL mode).

You can press the ON/SPEED Button (A) again to cycle the speed between:



Note: The panel will illuminate to show which SPEED is selected – LED's (K), (J) & (I).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS continued

4. OFF OFF

Press the OFF Button (B)

Memory Function


When you switch the unit off but leave it connected to the socket (and power is on) - The A-1612RC will remember which speed & mode(*) you last used! On your next use, it will commence operation in the last speed & mode set.

However, if the unit is unplugged or there is a power cut, the memory will be lost, and the unit will default back to LOW speed and NORMAL mode when you use it next time.

(*) SLEEP Mode & TIMER settings are not included in the memory function. SLEEP Mode will reset to NORMAL Mode.

5. MODE 🍣

To select the fan mode, press the MODE Button (C) – the unit will switch to SLEEP Mode. You can press the MODE Button (C) again to cycle the mode between:



Note: The panel will illuminate to show which MODE is selected – LED's (H), (G) & (F).

MODE	FUNCTION
Normal	Conventional wind - at the set speed This can be used with all SPEED settings
Nature	Creates an irregular & variable wind that is softer and more comfortable. This can be used with all SPEED settings
Sleep	The fan speed will slowly decrease to aid sleep – as indicated below: 1) HIGH speed - fan operates for 0.5hr (30 minutes) then reduces to MEDIUM speed. After a further 0.5hr (30 minutes) it will reduce to LOW speed until the TIMER time is over or turned off. 2) MEDIUM speed – fan operates for 0.5hr (30 minutes) then reduces to LOW speed until the TIMER time is over or turned off.
	3) LOW speed - the fan operates until the TIMER time is over or turned off.


OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS continued

6. TIMER



The timer allows you to set the runtime between 0.5hrs (30 minutes) to 7.5hrs (450 minutes) in 0.5hrs (30 minute) steps. When the timer function ends the unit will automatically switch off.

To set the timer – each press of the TIMER button (D) will add another 0.5hrs (30 minute) – cycling in steps:



Note: As the time is increased – more than one LED will illuminate as shown above - to designate the time selected - LED's (L), (M), (N) & (O). (eg 4.5hrs is shown as 4hrs (O) + 30mins (L) LED's illuminated)

To cancel the timer - press the TIMER button (D) multiple times until all LED's ((L), (M), (N) & (O)) are off.

7. SWING



Fan head can be oscillated from left to right.

To start the oscillation – press the SWING button (E).

To stop the oscillation – press the SWING button (E).

8. TILT

Fan head can be tilted up and down.

To tilt the head, simply move the motor housing (9) up or down gently until the fan is positioned as required. A series of clicks will be heard - this is normal.

AIR FRESHNESS

The Air Freshness module can be used as an Air Freshener or as a Mosquito Repellent by soaking the provided sponge pads with appropriate liquids.



We recommend that the sponge pads are sprayed/soaked with appropriate liquid, depending on operation mode. The sponge pad should be thoroughly wet but not dripping wet before inserting to your fans Air Freshness module.



MOSQUITO REPELLENT Orange sponge pad

can be used exclusively for the soaking of mosquito repellent liquid (*)



FRESHENER

White sponge pad

can be used exclusively for the soaking of air freshener liquid.

To fit the sponge pad - firstly, locate and remove the Air Freshness module grill cap (H) on the front grill (G).


To unlock, rotate counter clockwise and remove the grill cap (H).

Fit the soaked sponge pad to the inside of the grill cap (H) - push it in carefully, the tabs will secure it in place.

Refit the grill cap/sponge pad assembly to the front grill (G) and rotate clockwise to lock in place. Operate the fan as usual, following the user guidelines.

Note: the soaked sponge pad will dry out as the liquid is dispersed - this is normal. We recommend checking and recharge the sponge pad every 3-4 hours.

(*) **CAUTION**: Select a safe mosquito repellent liquid for use with this product. Many insecticide type products are unsafe for humans and animals through inhalation or contact with skin & eyes. Read the safety instructions of the repellent liquid carefully. If in doubt do not use it.



CARE AND CLEANING

This appliance requires little maintenance.

We recommend dust is cleaned from the fan blade and protective grills every few months, to keep it operating optimally.

After use and before cleaning, ensure the fan is OFF and the blades have come to a complete stop. Unplug the fan from the socket.

Disassemble the front & rear grill & fan. Wipe parts with a damp cloth.

Do not use abrasive cleaners, harsh detergents, chemical cleaners or solvents as they may damage the surface finish of the plastic components.

Refit the parts following the assembly instructions

Wipe the outside of oscillating fan body with a damp cloth and dry with another cloth or paper towel.

SERVICE & CUSTOMER CARE

There are no user serviceable parts inside this appliance.

If the power cord or plug are damaged it must, for safety reasons, be replaced by Binatone or an authorised Binatone repairer.
